Warranty Certificate

Skamp warrants each product manufactured by it to be free of defects in material and workmanship for a period of **six [6] months or 1000 hours** for parts and labor from the date of installation. Zenith Power Products warrants the engine to be free of defects in material and workmanship for a period of **twelve months** for parts and labor on major internal components from the date of installation. Zenith also warrants specified components for up to five years/3,500 hours. See attached Zenith warranty for details. Warranty on tires and battery are covered separately by their manufacturer.

Skamp's warranty is limited to the replacement of such parts as Skamp shall inspect and find defective in material and workmanship. This warranty shall not apply to Skamp's products which have been subject to accident, accelerated wear, unauthorized alterations, improper installation, lack of maintenance, or abuse.

Skamp shall not be held liable for any repairs or alterations by others except those made with Skamp's written consent. Prior written authorization must be obtained for repair parts and replacement with parts supplied by Skamp. Unauthorized repairs or the use of parts that have not been provided by Skamp will result in loss of warranty.

Except as shown in published catalogs or specifications, Skamp's products are not warranted to perform any particular task.

Skamp makes no warranty whatsoever with respect to accessories, parts or equipment not supplied by Skamp. The warranty of the original manufacturer only shall apply.

Skamp makes no warranty for direct, indirect or consequential loss, damage, or injury to persons or property, including that based upon strict liability, resulting for the use or possession of Skamp products.

There are no warranties which extend beyond those stated above and the description set out on the face hereof.

INTRODUCTION

This Introduction, along with the three (3) attached warranty certificates, together comprise the warranty package for your new Zenith Power Products (ZPP) engine. The various components of your ZPP engine are covered by one or more of the attached warranties, depending on the particular part manufacturer, the engine purchase date, and/or the engine's location. The purpose of this Introduction, which is not itself a warranty, is to explain how and when the various warranties apply. Please read this Introduction carefully and follow these directions for any warranty claims.

- **Engine Emission Components:** Your new ZPP engine has been designed, manufactured and certified to comply with recently adopted federal anti-smog standards, which require *that certain components* be covered by either a 3-year/2,500 hour or a 5-year/3,500 hour warranty, depending on the component. If you use your ZPP engine in any U.S. state other than California, the emission-related warranty will cover components whose failure would increase an engine's emissions, including electronic controls, fuel injection (for liquid or gaseous fuels), exhaust-gas recirculation, aftertreatment, or any other system developed to control emissions. The replacing or repairing of other components is the owner's responsibility.

- **Catalytic Converter and Catalytic Muffler** – The OEM- or Dealer-installed catalytic converter and/or catalytic muffler on your ZPP engine are manufactured by DCL International Inc. These components are subject to federal and state warranty requirements, and warranty claims are administered directly by ZPP. All warranty claims must be made to ZPP LLC, Customer Service Department.

- **Engine Warranty** – Regardless of where you use your engine, the ZPP engine will be covered by the *ZPP 12 months engine* "limited warranty"

- **California Engine Emission Components** - Your new ZPP engine has been designed, manufactured, and certified to comply with California state anti-smog standards, which require *certain emission-related components* be covered by either a three (3) year/2,500 hour or five (5) year/3,500 hour warranty. If you use your ZPP engine in California, the following emission-related parts of the engine are covered by the attached California Air Resources Board warranty, "YOUR WARRANTY RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS:"
 - Fuel Injection System
 - Air/Fuel Ratio Feedback
 - Electronic Control Module and Sensors
 - Catalytic Converter
 - Intake Manifold
 - Exhaust Manifold
 - PCV Valve
 - Oil Filler Cap
 - Distributor
 - Ignition Coil
 - Miscellaneous Parts In Systems listed above, including: hoses, belts, connectors, assemblies, clamps, fittings, tubing, sealing gaskets or devices, mounting hardware, pulleys, belts, and idlers
 - Throttle Body Assembly

Several warranties included in this Warranty Package require that you, as the original retail purchaser, timely complete and submit copies of the warranty certificates to ZPP, for purposes of registration. Please complete the required registration information and submit the designated copies to ZPP. Failure to submit the required registration could delay or prejudice your warranty claim.

IN THE EVENT OF A WARRANTY CLAIM, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO INITIATE THE CLAIM BY TAKING YOUR ZPP ENGINE TO AN AUTHORIZED ZPP DISTRIBUTOR OR, IF YOUR ZPP ENGINE CAME INSTALLED IN ANY VEHICLE OR OFF-ROAD PIECE OF EQUIPMENT, TO THE ORIGINAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER. FAILURE TO TIMELY INITIATE YOUR CLAIM MAY PREJUDICE YOUR RIGHT TO PROTECTION UNDER THE WARRANTIES.

EACH OF THE ATTACHED WARRANTIES LISTS APPLICABLE EXCLUSIONS. PLEASE READ THESE CAREFULLY AND BECOME FAMILIAR WITH THEM.
